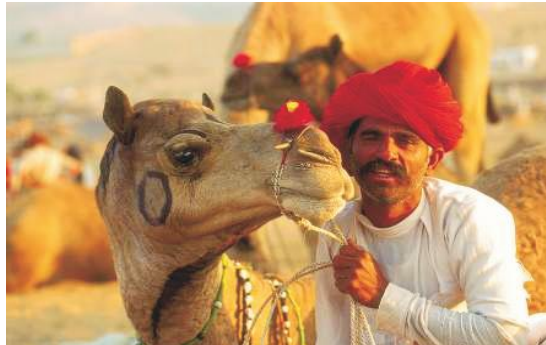

9 NIGHTS 10 DAYS**

Day01: DELHI:

Arrive in New Delhi, the capital of India and after a warm welcome, transfer to the hotel. After some rest and lunch, Visit India Gate and Presidents House. Overnight at the hotel.

Day02: DELHI:

After breakfast visit Humayuns Tomb. Humayun's tomb is the tomb of the great Islamic Mughal Emperor Humayun. The tomb was commissioned by Humayun's first wife Bega Begum (Hajji Begum) in 1569-70, and designed by Mirak Mirza Ghiyath, a Persian architect. It was the first garden-tomb on the Indian subcontinent, and is located in Nizamuddin East, Delhi, India, close to the Dina-Panah citadel also known as Purana Qila (Old Fort), that Humayun founded in 1533. It was also the first structure to use red sandstone at such a scale. The tomb was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1993. Later after lunch visit Qutub Minar. Qutub Minar is the tallest minaret in India; originally an ancient Islamic Monument, inscribed with Arabic inscriptions, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Located in Delhi, the Qutub Minar is made of red sandstone and marble. The tower has 379 stairs, is 72.5 meters (237.8 ft) high, and has a base diameter of 14.3 meters, which narrows to 2.7 meters at the top storey. Overnight at the hotel.

Day03: JODHPUR:

Fly to Jodhpur, the city of Rajasthan. After lunch, visit the palace constructed by Maharaja. The façade of the palace resembles a pyramid. The palace comprises of five stories. There are nearly 953 tiny windows carved out of intricate lattice work. These windows are extremely stylish and resemble a mammoth honeycomb.

Day04/ 05/ 06/ 07/ 08: JAISALMER

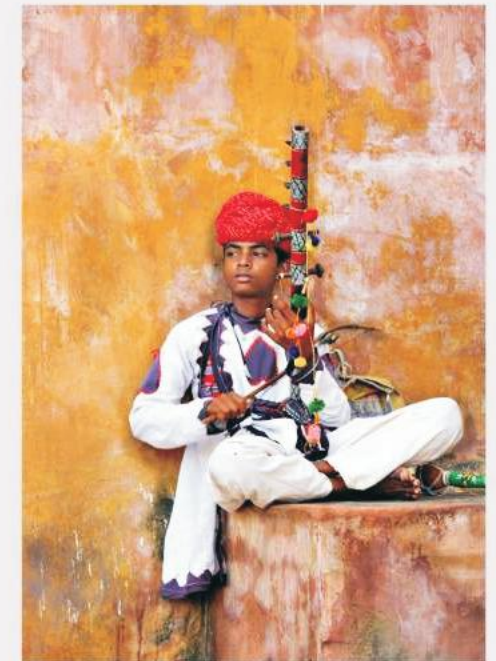
Today you get on the road to the fascinating golden desert town. The town is set in picturesque and rugged desert

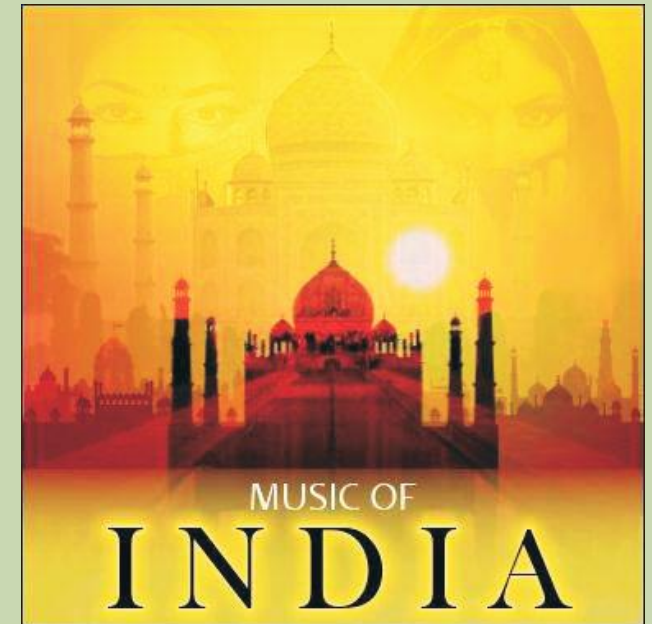
