## AMBER FORT

## HERITAGE TOUR (GOLDEN TRIANGLE) HEART OF INDIA 7 NIGHTS/ 8 DAYS

### Day01: DELHI:

Arrive in New Delhi, the capital of India and after a warm welcome, transfer to the hotel. After some rest and lunch, Visit India Gate and Presidents House. Overnight at the hotel.

### Day02: DELHI:

After breakfast visit Humayuns Tomb. Humayun's tomb is the tomb of the great Islamic Mughal Emperor Humayun. The tomb was commissioned by Humayun's first wife Bega Begum (Hajji Begum) in 1569-70, and designed by Mirak Mirza Ghiyath, a Persian architect. It was the first garden-tomb on the Indian subcontinent, and is located in Nizamuddin East, Delhi, India, close to the Dina-Panah citadel also known as Purana Qila (Old Fort), that Humayun founded in 1533. It was also the first structure to use red sandstone at such a scale. The tomb was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1993. Later after lunch visit Qutub Minar. Qutub Minar is the tallest minaret in India; originally an ancient Islamic Monument, inscribed with Arabic inscriptions, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Located in Delhi, the Qutub Minar is made of red sandstone and marble. The tower has 379 stairs, is 72.5 meters (237.8 ft) high, and has a base diameter of 14.3 meters, which narrows to 2.7 meters at the top storey. Overnight at the hotel.

### Day03: JAIPUR:

Drive to Jaipur, the pink city of Rajasthan. After lunch, visit Hawa Mahal, the palace of the winds constructed by Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh in 1799. The façade of the palace resembles a pyramid. The palace comprises of five stories. There are nearly 953 tiny windows carved out of intricate lattice work. These windows are extremely stylish and resemble a mammoth honeycomb. Later walk in the old city of Jaipur and shop as much as you like as this place is full of souvenirs and of course the gems of Jaipur are world famous.

### Day04: JAIPUR:

Today you get on an elephant back to visit the fascinating Amer fort. The Amer Fort set in picturesque and rugged hills is a fascinating blend of Hindu and Mughal architecture. Constructed by Raja Man Singh in 1592 and completed by Mirza Raja Jai Singh the fort is made in red

sand stone and marble. The rugged forbidding exterior belies an inner paradise with a beautiful fusion of art and architecture. Come back to the hotel for lunch and later visit the City palace museum which is situated inside the walled city. Later retire for the night.

### Day05: AGRA:

After morning breakfast drive to Agra. Enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri, built by Mughal Emperor Akbar in 1570. It was built in honor of Sufi saint Salim Chishti, who lived in a cavern on the ridge at Sikri and foretold the birth of his son, who was named prince Salim after the saint. Fatehabad as it was earlier known and later acquired the name of Fatehpur was the first planned city of the Mughals. It served as the capital of the Mughal Empire from 1571 until 1585. It was abandoned after 14 years because the water supply was inadequate to sustain the growing population and the unrest in North West. Lunch on the way. Later reach the hotel and rest. Evening free for shopping. Overnight at the hotel.

### Day06: AGRA:

Today you visit Agra, the city famous for its most romantic building "The Taj Mahal". In the morning visit Agra Fort, after lunch, visit the Taj Mahal, built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan in the memory of his third wife Mumtaz Mahal. The Taj Mahal is widely recognized as the jewel of Muslim art in India and one of the universally admired masterpieces of the world's heritage. Taj Mahal is the finest example of Mughal architecture, a style that combines elements from Persian, Turkish and Indian architectural styles. In 1983 The Taj Mahal became a UNESCO World heritage site. Later in the evening, enjoy your hotel spa, or just shop. Overnight at the hotel.

### Day07: DELHI:

Today after breakfast, drive to Delhi. Reach the hotel, have lunch and later in the afternoon, do some street shopping at Janpath. Overnight at the hotel.

### Day08:

Today after breakfast bid farewell to this enchanting country and you will be transferred to the international airport, to catch your flight back home.
